The Erasmus+ program offers students the opportunity to complete part of their Studies or Internship abroad. Detailed information is available on the website of the University of Thessaly: https://erasmus.uth.gr/gr/, by selecting the "Studies" or "Internship" menu.

Students of the Department of Physiotherapy can choose one of the partner universities in European Union countries for their mobility. The list of partner universities is available here: https://erasmus.uth.gr/gr/spoudes/etairoi-gr (search for the file related to the Department of Physiotherapy).

The International Relations Office of the University of Thessaly is responsible for coordinating the program. On its official website (<u>erasmus.uth.gr</u>), you can find information about the application process, required documents, and eligibility criteria.

Eligibility Criteria

Students who meet the following requirements can participate in the Erasmus+ program:

- They have completed at least the first year of studies.
- They have not yet completed the required number of credits to obtain their degree (i.e., there must be an available study period at the time of application submission).
- They are enrolled in an official degree program at the University of Thessaly (undergraduate, postgraduate, or doctoral).
- They have sufficient knowledge of the language of instruction at the host university (minimum level B1). A language proficiency certificate (OLS) is required for the approval of mobility.

Application Steps for Physiotherapy Students:

Step 1: Physiotherapy students who wish to participate in Erasmus+ must first contact the Erasmus Office in Lamia, located in the Library. Contact person: Mr. Spyros Karamitros. **Email:** skaramitros@uth.gr

Step 2: Once their application is approved, students must collaborate with the Academic Coordinator of the Department, Dr. Thomas Besios (**Email:** tbesios@uth.gr) to align the selected courses with their Learning Agreement.

For internships abroad, students can choose any organization related to Physiotherapy, with no restrictions on the country or host institution. The requirements for internships are determined by the Study Guide of the Department of Physiotherapy.
